 - Note Worthy Budget Items:
 - Reducing time on the pond aerator and lights on trees has decreased the electric bill somewhat
 - A&M Landscaping shows a small increase in their management fees for 2026
 - There will be an addendum to existing contract with A&M Landscaping to remove the cost of planting annuals, which should also result in reduced watering costs for annuals
 - Legal fee increased due to attorney expenses
 - No FHOA Fee increase for 2026

OPEN MEETING for PUBLIC COMMENTS

(Comments, Questions and Responses have been edited for clarity.)

- **5 Mayfair Circle:** Question #1: Wondering about the low water pressure experienced today and asked if anyone had the same problem. Question #2: Is there a place like Facebook where we could go to ask questions like where to get new gutters? Question #3: Where did the fake coyote come from and where has it gone?

BOARD RESPONSE: Question #1: American Water always says that they are working in the area whenever called about low water pressure and strange sounds. Complaints have been sent to the water department, but nothing is addressed. Question #2: There is a Vendor list available on the Fernbrooke.org website. Question #3: The Homeowner at 2 Fernbrooke placed the fake coyote to scare the geese away. It has to be moved around to be effective.

- **25 Mayfaire Circle:** Comment #1: Not everyone in the meeting may know how to raise their hand. Comment #2: I did call the American Water Company. They did come out and change my water meter, and it's just as noisy as the one they changed. Question #1: Will we be able to vote online for the By-Laws? Question #2: I did not get a ballot last year because I was away. Is there a way to resolve this problem? Question #3: What happens if we don't get two-thirds vote for the By-Laws? Question #4: Can documents that are for the Welcome Packet be sent to Bryan O'Neal since he prints the documents for the Packet? Question #5: How to register a landscaping, lawn mower complaint?



BOARD RESPONSES: Comment #1: The raised hand process was reviewed in the meeting and instructions will be provided at the beginning of the Public Comments portion for future meetings. Comment #2: No response required. Question#1: Online voting would require the use of a third-party company to manage the process and the cost is prohibitive. Question #2: Ballots are mailed out and must be returned inside of an envelope placed in another envelope to keep the vote anonymous. An option would be to call CPM before leaving the area and providing the secondary address if not available during the voting period. Only one vote will be registered for your address. Question #3: If the number of votes needed is not reached, we will have to keep pursuing the community for their vote. The Board is attempting to make the By Laws current and mandated by the State. The only thing that may result in objections is the fine increases in the Fine Fee Schedule. All other changes relate to what the state mandates. Question #4: Bryan O'Neal will be copied on emails with attachments for the Welcome Packet. Question #5: To register an landscaping company complaint, contact CPM by calling 856-802-1055 or submit a request via Vantaca, although calling would be best. CPM will then reach out to the landscaping company. It would be helpful to take pictures when they are using the large sit down mowers in your front yard and also get pictures of the damage.

- **10 Fernbrooke -** Comment: The fountain lights have been flickering lately. **BOARD RESPONSE:** The same problem with the flickering lights occurred last year. It may be due to a problem with the controller. When the contractor services the pump, we will request that they investigate the flickering lights. Thank you for reporting the issue.

- **Ralph Hendrickson** - mentioned people on the board who have done more than their fair share. Brian O’Neal was very helpful with migrating to the Vantaca online portal system. And thanks to John Caruso for taking care of the electricity, water and state regulation compliance and guiding the Board in the right direction in getting things done. Also Nancy Bivins for the amount of time and effort that she has put in to make this Board more effective with communicating with our community.
